"FOR THIS CAUSE"

- 1. **Cause** is a person or thing that acts, happens, or exists in such a way that some specific thing happens as a result; the producer of an effect: You have been the cause of much anxiety. What was the cause of the accident?
- 2. **Cause** is the reason or motive for some human action: The good news was a cause for rejoicing.
- 3. **Cause** is a good or sufficient reason: to complain without cause; to be dismissed for cause. "There was no CAUSE for that".
- Exo 9:16 And in very deed **for this** *cause* have I raised thee up, for to shew *in* thee my power; and that my name may be declared throughout all the earth.
- Mat 19:5 And said, **For this cause** shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh? PLUS (EPH. 5:28-33) (Psalms 78:22-32)
- <u>Joh</u> <u>12:27</u> Now is my soul troubled; and what shall I say? Father, save me from this hour: but **for this cause** came I unto this hour.
- <u>Joh</u> 18:37 Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, *Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice.*
- <u>Rom 1:26</u> **For this cause** God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature:
- Rom 15:9-12 And that the Gentiles might glorify God for *his* mercy; as it is written, **For this cause** I will confess to thee among the Gentiles, and sing unto thy name.
- Col 1:9 **For this cause** we also, since the day we heard *it*, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;
- <u>1Th</u> <u>2:13</u> **For this cause** also thank we God without ceasing, **because**, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, <u>ye received it not as the word of men</u>, but as it is in truth, the word of <u>God</u>, which effectually worketh also in you that believe.
- <u>1Th</u> <u>3:5</u> **For this cause**, when I could no longer forbear, I sent to know your faith, <u>lest by some</u> means the tempter have tempted you, and our labour be in vain.
- <u>2Th</u> <u>2:11</u> And **for this cause** God shall send them strong delusion, <u>that they should believe a lie:</u>
- <u>1Ti</u> 1:16 Howbeit **for this cause** I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might shew forth all longsuffering, <u>for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting.</u>
- <u>Tit 1:5</u> **For this cause** left I thee in Crete, <u>that thou shouldest set in order the things that are wanting</u>, and ordain elders in every city, as I had appointed thee:
