

## FREEDOM IS HAVING THE ABILITY TO CHOOSE

Exo 17:9 And Moses said unto Joshua, **Choose** us out men, and go out, fight with Amalek: to morrow I will stand on the top of the hill with the rod of God in mine hand.

Deu 14:24 And if the way be too long for thee, so that thou art not able to carry it; *or* if the place be too far from thee, which the LORD thy God shall **choose** to set his name there, when the LORD thy God hath blessed thee:

Deu 30:19 I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, *that* I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore **choose** life, that both thou and thy seed may live:

Deu 31:11 When all Israel is come to appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall **choose**, thou shalt read this law before all Israel in their hearing.

Jos 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, **choose** you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that *were* on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.

2Sa 17:1 Moreover Ahithophel said unto Absalom, Let me now **choose** out twelve thousand men, and I will arise and pursue after David this night:

2Sa 24:12 Go and say unto David, Thus saith the LORD, I offer thee three *things*; **choose** thee one of them, that I may *do it* unto thee.

1Ki 18:25 And Elijah said unto the prophets of Baal, **Choose** you one bullock for yourselves, and dress *it* first; for ye *are* many; and call on the name of your gods, but put no fire *under*.

1Ch 21:11 So Gad came to David, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, **Choose** thee

Psa 25:12 What man *is* he that feareth the LORD? him shall he teach in the way *that* he shall **choose**.

Pro 1:29 For that they hated knowledge, and did not **choose** the fear of the LORD:

Pro 3:31 Envy thou not the oppressor, and **choose** none of his ways.

Isa 7:15 Butter and honey shall he eat, that he may know to refuse the evil, and **choose** the good.

Isa 7:16 For before the child shall know to refuse the evil, and **choose** the good, the land that thou abhorrest shall be forsaken of both her kings.

Isa 65:12 Therefore will I number you to the sword, and ye shall all bow down to the slaughter: because when I called, ye did not answer; when I spake, ye did not hear; but did evil before mine eyes, and did **choose** *that* wherein I delighted not.

Isa 66:4 I also will **choose** their **delusions**, and will bring their fears upon them; **because** when I called, none did answer; when I spake, they did not

hear: but they did evil before mine eyes, and **chose that in which I delighted not.** (**They chose against the will of God.**)

Gen 13:11 Then Lot **chose** him all the plain of Jordan; and Lot journeyed east: and they separated themselves the one from the other.

Jos 24:22 And Joshua said unto the people, Ye *are* witnesses against yourselves that ye have **chosen** you the LORD, to serve him. And they said, *We are* witnesses.

1Sa 10:24 And Samuel said to all the people, See ye him whom **the LORD hath chosen**, that *there is* none like him among all the people? And all the people shouted, and said, God save the king.

1Sa 12:13 Now therefore behold the king whom **ye have chosen**, and whom ye have desired! and, behold, the LORD hath set a king over you.

1Ch 28:10 Take heed now; for the LORD hath **chosen** thee to build an house for the sanctuary: be strong, and do *it*.

2Ch 29:11 My sons, be not now negligent: for the LORD hath **chosen** you to stand before him, to serve him, and that ye should minister unto him, and burn incense.

Luk 10:42 But one thing is needful: and Mary hath **chosen** that good part, which shall not be taken away from her.

Joh 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I **chosen** you **twelve**, and one of you is a devil?

Joh 13:18 I speak not of you all: I know whom I have **chosen**: but that the scripture may be fulfilled, He that eateth bread with me hath lifted up his heel against me. (**If we were chosen for salvation, why wasn't Judas saved because he was chosen?**)

Joh 15:16 Ye have not **chosen** me, but I have **chosen** you, and ordained you, that **ye should go and bring forth fruit**, and *that* your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.

Joh 15:19 If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have **chosen** you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you.

Act 1:24 And they prayed, and said, Thou, Lord, which knowest the hearts of all *men*, shew whether of these two thou hast **chosen**,

Act 9:15 But the Lord said unto him, Go thy way: for he is a **chosen** vessel unto me, to bear my name before the Gentiles, and kings, and the children of Israel:

Eph 1:4 According as he hath **chosen** us in him before the foundation of the world, that we (**Who chose to believe**) should be holy and without blame before him in love:

2Th 2:13 But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning **chosen** you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and **belief of the truth**:

2Ti 2:4 No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of *this* life; that he may please him who hath **chosen** him to be a soldier.
