Hebrews 1:1-2 (KJV)

¹ God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets,

² Hath in these last days spoken unto us **by his Son**, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;

John 8:12-13 (KJV)

¹² Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

¹³ The Pharisees therefore said unto him, **Thou bearest record of thyself; thy record is not true.**

1. God the father hath spoken

John 5:37 And the Father himself, which have sent me, have borne witness of me. You have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his shape. 38 and ye have not his word abiding in you: for whom he hath sent, him you believe not.

2. The Old Testament hath spoken

John 5:39 – 40

³⁹ Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.

⁴⁰ And ye will not come to me, that ye might have life.

3. Moses has spoken

John 5:45-47

⁴⁵ Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father: there is *one* that accuseth you, *even* Moses, in whom ye trust.

⁴⁶ For had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed me: for he wrote of me.

⁴⁷ But if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe my words?

4. John the Baptist has spoken

John 1:6-7 (KJV)

⁶ There was a man sent from God, whose name *was* John.

⁷ The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all *men* through him might believe.

John 1:15 (KJV)

¹⁵ John bare witness of him, and cried, saying, This was he of whom I spake, He that cometh after me is preferred before me: for he was before me.

John 1:26-27 (KJV)

²⁶ John answered them, saying, I baptize with water: but there standeth one among you, whom ye know not;

²⁷ He it is, who coming after me is preferred before me, whose shoe's latchet I am not worthy to unloose.

John 1:29 (KJV)

²⁹ The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

John 1:32 (KJV)

³² And John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him.

John 1:36 (KJV)

³⁶ And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith, Behold the Lamb of God!

5. The Works of Jesus as spoken

John 5:36 (KJV)

³⁶ But I have greater witness than *that* of John: for the works which the Father hath given me to finish, the same works that I do, bear witness of me, that the Father hath sent me.

John 3:2 (KJV)

² The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him.

John 15:24 (KJV)

²⁴ If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father.

John 14:11 (KJV)

¹¹ Believe me that I *am* in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.

6. Jesus himself has spoken

John 8:14 (KJV)

¹⁴ Jesus answered and said unto them, Though I bear record of myself, *yet* my record is true: for I know whence I came, and whither I go; but ye cannot tell whence I come, and whither I go.

7. The Holy Spirit has spoken

8. John 15:26 (KJV)

²⁶ But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, *even* the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:

1 John 5:7, 9 (KJV)

⁷ For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.

⁹ If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: for this is the witness of God which he hath testified of his Son.

9. Believers have spoken

1 Corinthians 15:6-7 (KJV)

⁶ After that, he was seen of above five hundred brethren at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep.

⁷ After that, he was seen of James; then of all the apostles.
