THINK ON THESE THINGS

Philippians 1:10 (KJV) That ye may approve **things** that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ;

Philippians 1:12 (KJV) But I would ye should understand, brethren, that the **things** which happened unto me have fallen out rather unto the furtherance of the gospel;

Philippians 2:4 (**KJV**) Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.

Philippians 2:10 (KJV) That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of *things* in heaven, and *things* in earth, and *things* under the earth;

Philippians 2:14 (KJV) Do all **things** without murmurings and disputings:

Philippians 2:21 (KJV) For all seek their own, not the things which are Jesus Christ's.

Philippians 3:1 (**KJV**) Finally, my brethren, rejoice in the Lord. To write the same **things** to you, to me indeed *is* not grievous, but for you *it is* safe.

Philippians 3:7 (KJV) But what things were gain to me, those I counted loss for Christ.

Philippians 3:8 (KJV) Yea doubtless, and I count all **things** *but* loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all **things**, and do count them *but* dung, that I may win Christ,

Philippians 3:13 (KJV) Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but *this* one **thing** *I do*, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those **things** which are before,

Philippians 3:19 (KJV) Whose end *is* destruction, whose God *is their* belly, and *whose* glory *is* in their shame, who mind earthly **things** s.)

Philippians 3:21 (KJV) Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all **things** unto himself.

Philippians 4:8 (KJV) Finally, brethren, whatsoever **things** are true, whatsoever **things** are honest, whatsoever **things** are just, whatsoever **things** are pure, whatsoever **things** are lovely, whatsoever **things** are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these **things**.

Philippians 4:9 (KJV) Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you.

Philippians 4:12 (KJV) I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: every where and in all **things** I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need.

Philippians 4:13 (KJV) I can do all **things** through Christ which strengtheneth me.

Philippians 4:18 (KJV) But I have all, and abound: I am full, having received of Epaphroditus the **things** *which were sent* from you, an odour of a sweet smell, a sacrifice acceptable, wellpleasing to God.
