BELIEVE:

To credit upon the authority or testimony of another; to be persuaded of the truth of something upon the declaration of another, or upon evidence furnished by reasons, arguments, and deductions of the mind, or by other circumstances, than personal knowledge.

When we believe upon the authority of another, we always put confidence in his veracity. When we believe upon the authority of reasoning, arguments, or a concurrence of facts and circumstances, we rest our conclusions upon their strength or probability

- To expect or hope with confidence; to trust. -- Webster's Dictionary 1828
- Strong's G4103 pistos (believe):
- One who trusts in God's promises
- One who is convinced that Jesus has been raised from the dead
- One who has become convinced that Jesus is the Messiah and author of salvation
